

RE: CNHRPC Brownfields Advisory Committee

Dear Members of the Board of Selectmen:

The Central New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission (CNHRPC) was recently awarded an EPA Brownfield Assessment grant to conduct assessments of potentially contaminated (brownfield) sites in the region. With these funds, site assessments, cleanup planning, and reuse planning for a number of sites in the region can begin. This will then set the stage for cleanup activities.

The regional brownfields site selection process will be guided by a Brownfields Advisory Committee (BAC). The BAC will solicit nominations from the 20 communities within the region and identify properties for assessment, cleanup and reuse planning. The BAC will also work to develop site selection criteria and engage in a consultant selection process. The consultant (or consultants) will be a professional engineer who will assist with the technical and engineering aspects of the assessment, cleanup, and reuse planning process.

We are currently working to form the BAC and would like to extend an offer to an Allenstown representative for membership. If interested, please provide a letter indicating who from Allenstown would serve on the BAC. If Allenstown would not be able to provide membership to the BAC at this time please provide a brief response to that effect.

Please feel free to contact me or Matt Monahan at 226-6020 with more specific questions regarding the level of commitment to serve on the BAC. An initial meeting date will be identified later in October. We expect the BAC to meet on a monthly basis over the next two years.
