Thank you for taking good care of your LCHIP-assisted resource. We are sending the enclosed check in recognition that you conducted and reported appropriate and timely stewardship and monitoring in 2014. The payment is for the Allenstown Meetinghouse.

The LCHIP Monitoring Endowment fund was created to support long term stewardship of the resources protected with assistance from LCHIP. Payments are based on income available from the endowment, the number of projects receiving funds and a variety of resource-based factors. Because the amount available to provide these incentive payments may vary from year to year, we suggest that you do not include a specific payment from this source as part of your organization's annual budget.

Please keep LCHIP updated on your current work, as any projects that could potentially alter the exterior or interior of the resource must be approved by our office.

This letter also serves as a reminder that you will need to submit a completed 2015 monitoring report no later than the end of December 2015 to fulfill your agreement with LCHIP and to receive an incentive payment next year.
