## Call to Order

## **OLD BUSINESS**

#### Historic Site Markers

Chair Frascinella said he hasn't heard from anyone who wants to write property descriptions on the plaques. He said he sent a copy of the booklets to everyone on the Board and there are 16 locations currently. He would like Mr. and Ms. Verville to make sure he didn't overlook a property.

Chair Frascinella said they need to go photograph the locations as the appear today.

## • Commercial Properties Work Session

Chair Frascinella said Pork Chop Hill is probably in limbo right now due to a family death. There was a further discussion regarding the potential use for the property.

Chair Frascinella said the other property that he knows is taking gravel is the Assisted Living Facility to fill in around the building and the parking lot.

#### • Summer Concerts

Chair Frascinella said there is a concert coming up this Sunday and he has confirmation from the Armand Dupont School Student Council who are going to sell merchandise and a bake sale so they will have some food concession.

He contacted someone that Mr. Pelissier put him in touch regarding a food truck with but he hasn't received a response.

Chair Frascinella said that the Chief Lambert may be able to send a truck for the children and there will be an ice cream truck there as well. He said that corn hole did not work out for this concert. He said that Mr. Venegas handled it last year but they will see how it goes going forward.

He said the weather forecast has improved for Sunday so he is hopeful of a good turnout. The crucial item is getting the canopy assembled and he would like to see if they could bring it up from the basement this evening.

Chair Frascinella said with regard to yard signs, if anyone on the Board can return them to Town Hall after the concert. He said he had bought some red and blue markers for the signs but they faded very quickly. He said he may have to buy some frames so the wind doesn't bend them over and snap the legs of the sign.

Chair Frascinella said the next concert will be on June 12<sup>th</sup> and they are going to have the Boneshakerz which is more of a hard rock group so they will have to rework the signs and the flyers. Mr. Caruso asked if the Police Department could post it on their sign. Chair Frascinella said there could be a couple places they could advertise around town including social media.

The Board discussed having free popcorn for the next concert.

## • Town wide Yard Sale (May 21st):

Chair Frascinella said the last they heard from Ms. Pelissier, less than a dozen people have signed up. He said Pembroke is having theirs this Saturday. He said he could make up some flyers this weekend but he is not sure if it is on Facebook and wondered if they could get a volunteer to post on the different town's websites.

Mr. Caruso said the Hometown Hero Banners went up on Monday. He said there is a new one but it isn't finalized just yet.

Chair Frascinella said hopefully before the end of the month, Eversource will assist in getting the American flags upon School and Main along with the welcome banner at the edge of town.

## • 2022 EDC project list:

Chair Frascinella said they had talked about doing some improvements at the boat launch and the fishing bear is on order and should be ready in a few weeks. Mr. Pelissier was looking into getting tables and grills that will be cemented to the ground.

He said he has forgotten to round up email addresses for the local businesses as they want to spotlight some in the local newspaper.
