OLD BUSINESS

• Summer Concerts

Chair Frascinella said Catfish How is the upcoming performer for the next concert. Mr. Goodine installed some lights inside the gazebo so that may help with lighting.

Chair Frascinella said he has been trying to work on a story about the demolition of the Allenstown convent and to get a copy of it on the Town website.

He said the next thing he will be working on will be a news article and flyer for the upcoming concert. He said that they have not had anyone sign up yet for cruise night.

Mr. Caruso and Chair Frascinella discussed attending other cruise nights to see how they run.

New Concert Yard Signs

Chair Frascinella said the new concert yard signs arrived and he took them down to the Highway Department with some grade stakes for assembly. He said they look very good with the blue background and yellow lettering.

Hometown Hero Banners

Mr. Caruso and Chair Frascinella discussed that their contact was having a hard time finding a printer from Concord to Manchester to produce the new banners, however he should be able to find a printer within a week or two. The prices have may gone up. He has 17 banners backed up, 5 of which were for Allenstown.

He said it would be nice to have this material assembled before school starts. He said he would like to add this to the school district's curriculum as perhaps a walking field trip in town.

Chair Frascinella said he was thinking this week of sending out another reminder via the Town's website.

• Purple Heart Signs

Mr. Caruso said the signs are ordered and the way it works is the Town puts in the Purple Heart community signs. The signs for the Purple Heart trail are put in by the State. He said the trail sign will be put somewhere between Sully's and Aubuchon and the community signs will be placed at various locations including on Route 28, Deerfield Road and by the fire station.
