OLD BUSINESS

August Concert & Cruise Night

Chair Frascinella said they have yard signs out for the August 14th meeting. He said they put flyers at all of the stores in town and he posted a copy of it on his website. He said if the Board knows of any place else to post outside of Town, they can print copies from the website.

Mr. McDonald said Mr. Pelissier told him there was a publication that advertises car shows.

Chair Frascinella said he also posted links on the two local Facebook sites for the town.

He said the cook for the food concession is signed up and he has confirmed the Armand Dupont student council will be present with their table and bake sale. He said he hasn't heard from Chief Lambert yet about a fire truck for the kids.

Chair Frascinella said he went to the Pembroke concert the past weekend and they featured a good three piece band that played a lot of original country blues. He said there were about 20 people present, but it was a hot day without much shade or food concession.

He said since Pembroke will have a few more concerts this summer, they could attend to vet a potential performer for the Allenstown concerts.

Historic Site Markers
