The July 29, 2020 virtual meeting of the Economic Development Committee was called to order by Chairman Mike Frascinella at 6:45 pm.

Chair Frascinella read a statement establishing authority to hold an electronic meeting, along with remote viewing and listening guidelines.

OLD BUSINESS

American Flags

Chair Frascinella stated that seven (7) additional American flags have been ordered and that Eversource wants the pole numbers instead of a map to identify their locations. He asked if an EDC member would be willing to get those numbers.

Mr. Venegas said he would do that.

Welcome Banners

Chair Frascinella asked for feedback on the Welcome banners.

Mr. Pelissier said he is concerned about possible vandalism of those outside of town. He said the Highway Department is replacing signs constantly because of this. He added that big trucks might knock down those close to the road.

Chair Frascinella said there are only three that are outside of the downtown area. He asked Mr. Goodine about liability.

Mr. Goodine said there is a \$500 deductible, so the Town's insurance would not be helpful.

Mr. Venegas suggested leaving the banners for now and removing them if there are problems.

Hometown Heroes Banners

Mr. Pelissier reported speaking with relatives of one of the identified veterans. They like the idea and will attempt to find photos and information.

Chair Frascinella said that two flags are ready to install, but Matt Seiler has been ill and not able to install them.

Mr. Pelissier said he will install the two banners.

2020 Concerts

Chair Frascinella asked Committee members to meet this Friday at 4:30 pm to chalk the areas for distancing during the Green Heron bluegrass concert on Sunday August 2nd. The portapotty will be delivered Friday.

Mr. Goodine said he has masks and sanitizers.

Chair Frascinella proposed scheduling the Crazy Steve & Friends concert early in September, perhaps the Sunday after Labor Day. He said they have a third possibility – a blue/rock band called Argo. He asked Mr. Goodine to play a sampling of their music.

Mr. Pelissier said he liked the music.

Chair Frascinella said they also have the possibility of booking Nicole Knox Murphy, a country singer from Candia.

Walking Tour of Historic Homes

Chair Frascinella said there is nothing to report on this project.

Park Passes

Chair Frascinella reported that the Park only allows 450 people into the Park each day, a policy he does not agree with since those visiting the Park go to many different locations.

Proclamation for Retiring Doctor Albee

Mr. McDonald said he would contact Dr. Albee tomorrow to try to establish a date. The ceremony would take place at the Community Center to allow for social distancing.

Blueberry Express Mural

Chair Frascinella reported no action on this project since the last meeting when Mr. Goodine suggested seeking a grant from the State Council on the Arts.

Drive-In Movie

Chair Frascinella stated that they would continue working on this project after the Sunday concert. The location needs to be scoped out and a full equipment test needs to be conducted.

NEW BUSINESS

Allenstown T-Shirts

Mr. Pelissier said he has been looking at clip art for a bear motif; he likes some that he has seen but hasn't found an ideal one. He said it is important to minimize the number of colors. He said they need to identify the best clip art and come up with a slogan for the t-shirts.

Industrial Site

Chair Frascinella reported that Charlie Morgan asked him for help finding an industrial site for a distribution center, which he did, coming up with six (6) possible sites and providing property cards and screen shots for each. Mr. Pelissier and he identified two sites on Route 28 – a 4.25-acre parcel and a 36-acre parcel. On Chester Turnpike near Granite Street, they located an 11-acre parcel and a five-acre parcel next to the Family Dollar store. At the corner of River and Dodge Roads, they identified a 59-acre parcel, and at the south end of Chester Turnpike, they found a 22-acre parcel. There is a concern, they said, about availability of sewer and water.

Mr. Goodine consulted the VUEWorks program to try to determine how close these parcels are to sewer and water hook-ups. He noted that the population of Allenstown is approaching 5,000, with the China Mill and Optimus Senior Living, creating a customer base conducive to development. He said that developers explore quality of life and place factors, looking at population, traffic, recreation opportunities, and tax break incentives.
