OLD BUSINESS

June 25 Concert

Ms. Lemire stated that the June 25th concert had to be cancelled due to weather. We should have a backup plan as there is another concert on August 13 and another on September 10th. What would be a viable back up plan to maybe have this indoors. Mr. Frascinella said the school gym would not be a viable option because they need to know months in advance to hire a custodian and we cannot bring in food.

Mr. Adinolfo stated that once we take possession of the old Allenstown Elementary School, we would not have many options.

Lisa Lemire said we could have a rain date or maybe this past weather was just a fluke. Lisa said we should look for a date for Jen Mitchell for next year.

Mr. Frascinella suggested when we book the musicians we ask if they also have the following Sunday as a rain date.

Mr. Caruso suggested waiting until we have our own location at AES. We can talk to all the musicians and find out what they have available for next year.

Boat Launch Improvements: Chad was to present suggestions for picnic tables and fire pits, and estimated costs but was unable to attend the meeting.

Historic Downtown Tour: Need to finish this project. Get out and take photos. Ms. Lemire said we still need to keep this on the agenda and get this done.

Spotlight on New Businesses: Awaiting transcriptions of interviews with two new businesses. Ms. Lemire said she has been texting with Zachary with E&I Home Improvement and he said he has filled out the questionnaire on line, but she does not know where to find that. She will check back with Zachary, the owner and ask him to email her with the answers.

Mr. Frascinella said he prefers to do the interview in person and feels you get a lot more information.

NEW BUSINESS

August 13 Concert & Cruise Night:

Ms. Lemire said she and Nancy would send out flyers. BoneShakerz is scheduled. Concert battle plan started June 18. Determine a backup plan if bad weather.

Mr. Frascinella said there was a lot of details on the yard signs. It costs \$15 per sign in multiples of 10. He asked if 25 would be enough. Ms. Lemire said it is great to have the location of the signs so whoever puts them out knows the location.
