- Update on the Community Power Survey

Ms. MacDowell advised that approx. 48 survey responses had been received as of Feb 06, 2023, with almost 80% of the responses in favor of a community power program. Mr. O'Meara provided one (1) additional hard-copy survey that had been gathered following a meeting with individuals at the Senior Center on Feb 02, 2023 that was attended by Mr. McDonald, Mr. Goodine, Mr. Arsenault, and Mr. O'Meara.

It was reconfirmed that Wednesday, February 8<sup>th</sup> would be the last day to solicit and submit survey responses., as this will provide time for Standard Power to update the Community Power Plan for final review by the Committee at a meeting planned for February 13, 2023, at which time the Committee would vote to approve the final plan, in time for inclusion in printed Town Ballots for the March 2023 Town Meeting.

- Communications Packet / FAQ

Mr. McDonald discussed potentially using a public document from the City of Lebanon as a basis for the Allenstown FAQ and stated that he believed it addressed the topics the Committee wished to cover. Following discussions with Ms. Manns, it was decided to use portions of this document along with information previously gathered by the Committee to create the proposed FAQ for Allenstown, which Standard Power will bring before the Committee at its Feb 13, 2023 meeting.

Mr. Manns advised that Standard Power does not yet have copies of notifications to NH residents to share with the Committee but agreed to share samples of notifications previously used for MA residents by way of example.

















Brian Arsenault made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Ron Adinolfo.
