Meeting came to order at 4:00 PM.

1. Open Bid documents for Ferry Street paving and guardrail project.

- John Jackman opened all bids received.
- Results are as follows:
 - Suburban Paving Company \$77,062.00
 - Advanced Excavation & Paving \$83,080.00
 - Bii Fence & Guardrail \$2,200.00 (bid only on guardrail)
- Charles made a motion to award the contract to Suburban Paving Company in the amount if \$77,062.00. Jeffrey seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
