# I. Project Updates

#### **Suncook Pond Station**

Mr. Trainque begins with an overview of the Suncook Pond Pump Station project and prospective options for placement. Mr. Lemire expresses his concern of the negative effect it would possibly have to his home upon resale. Mr. Lemire questions the possibility of purchasing the land in question. Mr. Trainque responded that there will need to be an assessment on the property to determine the value for both options of the purchase of the easement, or the outright purchase. Mr. Lemire reinstates the he would rather not have that land on his deed, as it would affect his resale value. Mr. Lemire also informs the Commission that he does have a bay line drain in his basement which he would like retain.
