New Business:

Abatement Request

The property owner of 3 Reserve Street, Allenstown submitted a request for a Sewer Abatement. Owner states that he had to run his water during the colder winter days to avoid the pipes freezing. Because the increase in consumption was of an intentional nature and because the water going down the drain was processed at the plant, the abatement was denied.

I. Wastewater Asset Management

Michael Trainque states that the Wastewater Asset Management with Vueworks is going well. The next step would be for John Jackman to sit with the Commissioners in a public training session, at a time to be determined at a later date. Also sitting in on the training would be a member from DES.

II. Suncook Pond Pump Station

Michael Trainque reviews the updates for the Commission with progress with the Suncook Pond Pump Station and overviews the structural work is in progress. He advises that he spoke to the Pembroke Water Department and was informed that they cannot connect through Suncook Pond Estates and will have to connect through Library Street water line. In speaking with the Water Department, they have mentioned that there are water mains that need to be replaced on that road, and propose sharing the cost to replace the water mains with the Sewer Department. Mr. Rodgers expresses concern over the cost with delays a/o surprises and is concerned for the timeline of this project.

Mr. Trainque reviewed the easement areas for the pump station project and states he is waiting for appraisals for the both purchase and temporary easements from the Appraiser.

Mr. Caporale asks why we could not just go forward with the eminent domain route. Mr. Trainque replies that he believes that an offer should be extended before eminent domain can be acted on.

Mr. Caporale asks if the Commission is required to extend an offer.

Mr. Trainque replied that he will get a definite answer on that for the Commission.

Mr. Trainque explains that there are different values on purchases and eminent domain appraisals and that he is waiting for both values from the appraiser. Mr. Trainque also reviews the process of eminent domain application procedures. Mr. Caporale urges Mr. Trainque to obtain the appraisals as soon as possible. No motions made, no motion passed.
