Notice is hereby given in accordance with RSA 676:4 that the Allenstown Planning Board will review the following submitted application(s) for completeness on **Wednesday, January 15, 2020, at a meeting beginning at 6:30 PM at the Allenstown Town Hall, 16 School Street, Allenstown, NH.** If the application(s) are accepted as complete by the Board, a public hearing will follow immediately after. Applications continued to a subsequent meeting will not be re-noticed.

The following application has been submitted for review and public hearing by the Planning Board:

1. **Site Plan. Grossman Suncook, LLC/43 Allenstown Road. Case #02-2020.** Map 106, Lots 31 & 32 and totaling 2.49 +/- acres on land owned by the same for the purpose of establishing a lawn/garden/ equipment rental and sales in a space used previously for a pharmacy.

The following planning board application form will be considered for review, public hearing, and adoption by the Planning Board:

1. **Application Form. Conditional Use Permit Application.** To revise the Conditional Use Permit Application Form to provide guidelines for Suncook Infill projects and Mill Redevelopment projects in accordance with Article XXIII of the Allenstown Zoning Ordinance.
