POW/MIA Chair of Honor Display Guidelines

Rolling Thunder®, Inc. POW/MIA Chair of Honor displays are as unique as each location they are in. There are not a tremendous amount of guidelines, but if you have a question, please e-mail joe.dentremont@rollingthunderma1.org.

For Displays in Public Spaces

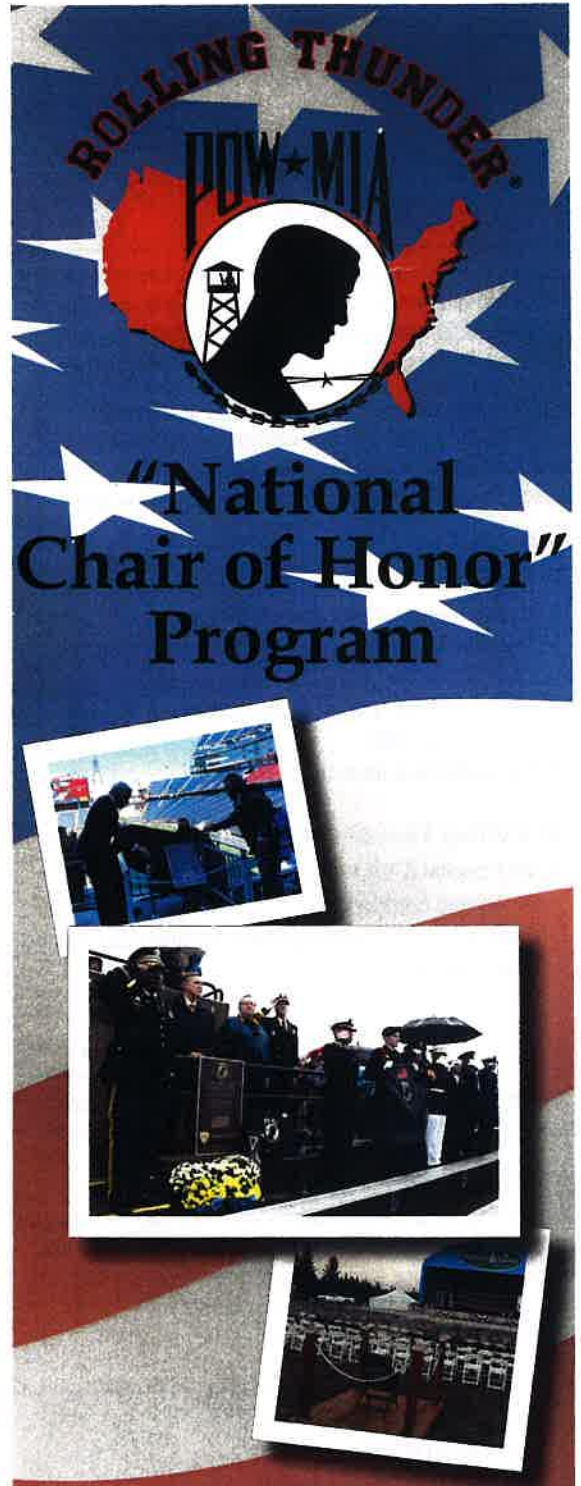
- Seat must be cordoned off to prevent use
- Fixed seats must be accompanied by a memorial plaque
- Memorial plaques can be placed either in front of or behind the chair, but should be on the side with the most traffic as the site warrants
- If flags are included as a part of the display, as you are reading the memorial plaque or memorial text on the chair seat, the American flag shall be to the viewer's left and the POW/MIA flag to the viewer's right
- Every RT POW/MIA Chair of Honor shall receive a dedication ceremony, to occur on or before its first public appearance

For Rolling Thunder®, Inc. Chapter Activities

- Seat must be cordoned off to prevent use
- If flags are included as a part of the display, as you are reading the memorial plaque or memorial text on the chair seat, the American flag shall be to the viewer's left and the POW/MIA flag to the viewer's right
