The following application has been submitted for review and public hearing by the Planning Board:

- 1. Subdivision and Lot Line Adjustment Application. Franklin Associates, on Behalf of MDFG LLC. Case #01-2021.** Map 402, Lot 141 and Mount Delight and Kettle Rock Road, in the Open Space and Farming (OSF) Zone. The applicant seeks approval to adjust the lot line between two lots and subdivide the additional lot.
