**RE: TRAFFIC DETAILS FOR NHEC OUTDOOR LIGHTING WORK**

**SUMMARY:**

Please be advised that effective January 1, 2019, NHEC will no longer pay for traffic control when working to install, remove or repair outdoor lights in your town. If your town requires a traffic detail at an outdoor lighting work site, these costs will be paid for by the member who is responsible for the monthly cost of the light.

NHEC will continue to practice its traffic safety procedures at all work sites by placing signage and safety cones around work areas. We will also continue to request additional traffic control measures (paid by others) if we determine they are necessary to protect the safety of motorists, pedestrians and our employees. Municipalities still have the option to require traffic control at all NHEC outdoor lighting work sites, but the costs will be borne by the member who is responsible for the monthly cost of the light.
