ALLENSTOWN PLANNING BOARD NOTICE OF APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given in accordance with RSA 676:4 that the Allenstown Planning Board will review the following submitted application(s) for completeness on **Wednesday**, **January 3**, **2024**, **at a meeting beginning at 6:30 PM at the Allenstown Town Hall**, **16 School Street**, **Allenstown**, **NH**. If the application(s) are accepted as complete by the Board, a public hearing will follow immediately thereafter. Applications that are continued to a subsequent meeting will not be re-noticed.

The following application(s) have been submitted for review and public hearing by the Planning Board:

- 1. Subdivision/Lot Line Adjustment. <u>Allenstown Aggregate</u>. Case #2023-02. Map 106, Lots 18 and 18-1 at 169 Granite Street in the Open Space and Farming (OSF) Zone. Applicant requests approval to adjust the lot line between a five-acre lot and 112-acre lot.
- **2. Site Plan.** Allenstown Aggregate. Case #2023-03. Map 106, Lots 18-1 at 169 Granite Street in the Open Space and Farming (OSF) Zone. Applicant requests approval to construct a multitenant metal building with associated parking.
- **3. Subdivision.** McNamara Two-Lot Subdivision. Case #2023-04. Map 113, Lot 41 at Main Street in the R1 Zone and MS4 Overlay District. Applicant requests approval to subdivide a two-acre lot from a 16-acre lot.
