# The Senior Center is Closed Wednesday, June 19, In recognition of Juneteenth.

#### What is Juneteenth?

It is a holiday celebrated on June 19 to commemorate the emancipation of enslaved people in the US. The holiday was first celebrated in Texas, where on that date in 1865, in the aftermath of the Civil War, enslaved people were declared free under the terms of the 1862 Emancipation Proclamation.

June 19,1865, is when the last Confederate community of enslaved Americans in Galveston, Texas, received word that they had been freed from bondage. Union General Gordon Granger led the unit in Galveston who would ensure the proclamation was enforced in Texas at the end of the American Civil War. **Juneteenth** is just a portmanteau of the words "June" and "nineteenth".

#### Easy Low Cost Sweet Snack Cracker Toffee

1 c Chocolate Chips

#### Inaredients:

40 Saltines (1 sleeve) 2 Sticks of Butter 1 c Brown Sugar

#### Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 400<sup>0</sup> F
- 2. Line a cookie sheet with foil. Place the saltines in pan evenly and not overlapping.
- 3. Over medium heat, melt butter and brown sugar. Bring the mixture to a boil constantly stirring for two minutes. Pour the mixture over the saltines spreading it evenly.
- 4. Bake for about five minutes until it is bubbly. Saltines may shift just move back into place with butter knife.
- 5. Quickly sprinkle the chocolate chips on top, and let them melt. Spread the chocolate once melty, with a knife.
- 6. Then refrigerate until set. Peal of foil, break apart and serve.
