Call to Order

The Allenstown Trustees of the Trust Funds & Cemetery Trustees Meeting of November 15, 2022 was called to order by Chair Richard Caruso at 5:02 pm. This meeting was delayed from October 15, 2022.

Review Q3 2022 Financial Statements (Jul 2022 - Sept 2022)

Chair Caruso said at the beginning of July 1, 2022, the market value of the portfolio was \$2,633,760.19 and received an income of \$551,071.00 with expense and disbursements were \$28,076.41 with a realized gain or loss of \$2,439.81.

He said the overall change, or realized gain or loss, was \$2,439.81 making the overall change with a realized gain or loss \$20,421.40. This leaves them with a market value at the end of the period of \$2,649,417.80.

He said for the month of August, 2022, for the market value, they received an income of \$403,482.25, with a realized gain or loss of \$3,575.81 for a total change in unrealized loss of \$34,727.27. The market value at the end of August was \$3,014,596.25.

Chair Caruso said in the report for September 1, 2022, the received income was \$3,679.69 with a realized loss of \$3,038.32 for a total change and unrealized loss of \$48,669.97 leaving them a market value of \$2,966,567.65.

Chair Caruso said looking at the quarterly reports, that it is trending the way the market is, and everything is now starting to dip a bit.

Fire Department Equipment CRF Withdrawal Request- Rescue Tools and Fire Nozzles; The Board of Selectmen request a withdrawal from the Fire Department Equipment Capital Reserve Fund to reimburse the Town for the purchase of Portable Radio and Accessories in accordance with the list of equipment provided by the FD. The request is for \$3,476.00 to be transferred to the General Fund Account ending in 8125 for the expense of the various items to be purchased.

Chair Caruso said they have two requests today and one is for the transfer of \$34,069.11 from the Public Safety Building Capital Reserve Fund to the Town General Fund ending in 8125 per the signed request by the Selectboard. He said the revised amount is set by Mr. Goodine.
